WORKSHOP PART 3

With Professor Wendorff Jörg, who teaches communication at Ravensburg University of Applied Sciences, we looked at the ideas and projects of young people in Europe.

First we listened to the explanation of the swimming pool in Wangen, which was renovated by young people, by first interviewing young people and children to find out how this could be done and then putting the wishes into practice.
